<u>Competition format</u>: Modified WKF/AKF rules (if in doubt check WKF website) Competitors for kata and kumite will require red and blue belts (no writing permitted on belts, only manufactures label)

<u>Compulsory equipment for kumite</u>: Mouth guard, groin guard (males), breast guard (females, optional for 13 yrs. & under), hand mitts, shin & instep protectors (red OR blue one colour accepted), face mask or head protector (children 5-13 years), body protectors (all divisions).

**Competition dress:** White karate gi only. Female competitors permitted to wear a white t-shirt under their gi top. No jewellery. No metal hair clips/pins, head bands, etc. - hair may be tied back using a discrete rubber band/hair tie.

<u>Kata:</u> Free choice kata. All children's divisions may repeat kata, but NOT in successive rounds. Cadet divisions and above may NOT repeat kata. **NO BUNKAI REQUIRED FOR TEAM KATA for this tournament (variation from WKF rules) Team** competitors cannot change during the 3 rounds of championships.

Kumite: Children & cadet divisions 90 second rounds, juniors & seniors 120 second rounds.

2- I hereby acknowledge that my entry and/or participation in the tournament carries with it significant risk of personal injury. 3- Therefore, I for myself and Releasors hereby relinquish, release and/or waive any action against the Releasees for any personal injury sustained by me arising out of and/or in the course of the tournament, whether as a result of any disregard and/or action and/or technical breach of the Rules of the Tournament or otherwise.

4- In addition, in the event of any action being commenced, I for myself and the Releasors hereby indemnify against any cost and damages arising from or connection therewith.
